MAP SCORE ACCESS

Thank you for supporting your child during MAP testing. To access your child's MAP score, you will need to log in to HCPSS connect as a parent.

Please see below for directions. A more detailed home report will be available in Synergy by early November.

How Can I Access my Child's MAP Test Results?

Fall 2020 MAP test results are entered in Synergy the Friday after a student takes the test.

It can take up to 24 hours to become visible for an individual student.

To access test scores:

- 1. Log in to HCPSS Connect
- 2. Select More Options from the left panel
- 3. Select Standardized Test Scores from the middle

HOW TO ENTER:

- <u>Photography</u>
- <u>Visual Arts</u>
- General Rules

1. Fill out an Entry Form, and be sure to include your Artist's Statement, which is how your artwork connects to the theme (50% of your score from the judges). Details for getting started can be found on the PTA website at https://cespta.net/programs/

Artwork will be judged in 3 categories:

- <u>Primary</u> (Grades K-2)
- Intermediate (Grades 3-5), and
- <u>Special Artist</u> (for students with challenges as covered in the ADA).

Entries will be reviewed by experienced arts and education judges. All participants will be celebrated with certificates of participation, the top three entries will receive ribbons and the first place entry will receive a medal. The top three entries in each category will move on to the Howard County Reflections Contest; the top three County entries will move on to the Maryland State Reflections Contest, and State winners in each category will compete in the National PTA Reflections Contest. **EVERY artwork will be celebrated!**


